Interlocutor's Instructions

PART 1 (2 minutes)

I: LanguageCert International ESOL, Speaking, Access level, *(give today's date)*.

(Give candidate's full name.) Exam begins. Hello. My name's *(give full name)*. Can you spell your surname for me, please?

- C: *(Spells surname.)*
- I: Thank you. Where are you from?
- C: (Responds.)
- I: Thank you. Now, Part One. I'm going to ask you some questions about yourself. (Choose **up to five** questions, one from each of the different topic areas, as time allows. Name the topic; e.g. 'Now, **Music**.')

Topics

Music

- Who is your favourite singer or band?
- Tell me about a music concert you've been to.
- Which musical instruments can you play?
- Do you study music at school?

Jobs

- What jobs do the people in your family do?
- Which job would you like to do? (Why?)
- What are some jobs that pay well in your country?
- Which do you think is better: a job that pays well or an interesting job? (Why?)

The area you live in

- Tell me some good things about your area.
- Where can you play sport in your area?
- How long have you lived in your area?
- How easy is it to travel around in your area? (Why?)

Your home

- What sort of place do you live in?
- Who do you live with?
- Which is your favourite room in your home? (Why?)
- In future, would you like to live in a house or a flat? (Why?)

(continued)

Friends

- Tell me about your best friend.
- How often do you talk to your friends online?
- How much time do you spend with friends?
- What do you usually do with your friends at weekends?

C: (Responds.)

- I: (Interlocutor responds and/or comments **briefly**.)
- I: Thank you.

PART 2 (2 minutes)

I: Now, Part Two. I'm going to read some situations. I want you to start or answer. First situation (*choose one situation from* **A**).

Α

- We're friends. I start. I've left my wallet at home.
- We're friends. I start. What game should we play after school?
- I'm a shop assistant in a clothes shop. I start. *Can I help you?*
- We're strangers on a bus. I start. Do you know how far from the castle this bus stops?

C: (Responds.)

- I: *(Role-play the situation with candidate approximately two turns each.)*
- I: Second situation (choose one situation from **B**).

- You are a tourist and you're looking for the shopping centre. You start.
- I work in a railway ticket office. You want to buy a ticket. You start.
- We're friends. You're late for a class. You start.
- I'm your teacher. You won't be at school tomorrow. You start.

C: (Initiates.)

- I: (Role-play the situation with the candidate approximately two turns each.)
- I: (Role-play a third situation from **A** or **B** if time allows.)
- I: Thank you.

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PART 3 (2 minutes)

I: Now, Part Three. Here's a picture of a street. *(Hand over candidate's task sheet.)* I have a different picture of a street. Some things are different. You and I must find the differences. I start.

PART 4 (3 minutes including follow-up questions)

I: In Part Four, you are going to talk on your own about something for one minute. You are going to talk about *(choose topic for candidate).*

Topics

- A The school you go to
- B An interesting holiday that you have had
- C How to learn vocabulary in another language
- I: (Hand over piece of paper and pen/pencil.) You now have thirty seconds to write some notes to help you.
 You are going to talk about (repeat topic). (Withdraw eye contact for thirty seconds. Leave recorder running.)
- I: *(Candidate's name)*, please start.
- C: (Talks.)
- I: (When candidate has talked for a maximum of one minute, say, 'Thank you', and then ask some follow-up questions.)

Follow-up questions

The school you go to

- How would you improve your school?
- How many different schools have you been to?
- How much longer will you study at your school?
- What will you do after you finish at your school?

An interesting holiday that you have had

- What was the best part about it?
- Would you ever do it again? (Why?/ Why not?)
- What kind of people would **NOT** enjoy this activity? (Why?)
- What did you learn from doing this?

How to learn vocabulary in another language

- What sort of words did you first learn in English?
- What do you think is difficult about learning new words?
- How many different languages can you speak?
- Which language would you like to learn next? (Why?)
- I: Thank you, *(give candidate's name.)* That is the end of the exam.
