# SPEAKING TEST COMMENTS

Criteria	Mark	Comments
Task Fulfilment & Communicative Effect	3	Some tasks are carried out more successfully than others and listening to the candidate places strain on the listener (a patient listener may be required). Some answers are not always supported with enough detail. As a result thorough communication is not always achieved.
Coherence	2	The candidate's responses are not always clearly structured. There is a lack of coherence at times, especially when the candidate produces longer responses. There is also limited use of cohesive devices.
Accuracy & Range of Grammar	2	A limited range of grammar is used and the candidate does not manage to deal with the tasks effectively. Basic structures are most of the time successfully used but there are errors in the more complex ones. Meaning is not always clear to the listener.
Accuracy & Range of Vocabulary	2	Only a basic range of vocabulary is used and the candidate does not manage to tackle the tasks effectively. Meaning is not always clear.
Pronunciation, Intonation & Fluency	2	The candidate does not manage to maintain the flow of language due to hesitations and pauses which cause some strain for the listener and sometimes obscure meaning. There are some inappropriate stress and intonation patterns. The read aloud tasks is not carried out naturally nor fluently.

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
