Criteria	Mark (0-6)	Evaluation
Task Completion and Communicative Effect	6	The test taker achieves tasks with competence and naturalness, effectively addressing all questions and providing relevant, detailed responses. He demonstrates a solid understanding of the topics discussed and is fully communicative, engaging well in the conversation.
Fluency and Discourse Management	5	He speaks fluently and maintains a smooth flow of speech, with only negligible hesitation. Ideas are logically connected, significant points successfully highlighted, and examples used effectively.
Accuracy and Range of Grammar	5	He uses a broad range of grammatical structures and demonstrates consistently good command of grammar, making only a few errors (e.g., 'they don't have no one'), which do not impact meaning.
Accuracy and Range of Vocabulary	5	He uses a wide range of carefully selected vocabulary as well as some idiomatic language to get his message across. While there are some inaccuracies, mainly attributable to first language interference, the overall meaning is effectively conveyed.
Pronunciation and Intonation	6	His pronunciation is generally clear and easy to understand, making effective use of stress, rhythm, and intonation to express interest and emphasise points. While a slight accent is present, it does not impede comprehension.
Total score CEFR level: C1	27 (out of 30)	Overall: The test taker communicates effectively, showing a solid understanding of the topics with well-structured responses. Minor grammatical errors and occasional hesitations do not hinder communication. His fluency, choice of vocabulary, and pronunciation reflect a strong C1 level command of English, indicating readiness for advanced use in professional contexts.
